WHAT IS SO SPECIAL ABOUT ALOR

Alor is known for clear water and unique marine life, as well as for its diversity: black sand muck dive sites, vibrant and fishy coral slopes and amazing walls are all within a 15 to 40 minutes boat ride from our resort.

Thanks to the community's utilization of *traditional fishing methods*, such as spear fishing and fish traps, that are *respectful of the coral*, the reefs have remained in pristine condition.

ALOR DIVERS ECO RESORT









Alor Divers is an intimate eco dive resort, situated on Pantar Island, with a 450m long sandy beach and a stunning housereef.

To preserve the *authentic atmosphere* of the place, we took special care while integrating the resort into the surrounding environment. To enhance *friendly ambiance* and *personalized service*, the number of guests is limited to 16.

Locals from nearby villages, few assistants from the main town of the region, Kalabahi, along with Western management make up our *hospitable working team*, who are committed to ensure everyone has a *memorable stay in*.

Just a few fin kicks away from the beach, right in front of our bungalows, the housereef is amazing: a stunning coral garden, perfect for snorkeling, and two walls separated by a slope, offering various underwater habitats to explore.

DELUXE BUNGALOW

For our resorts' best locations, we envisioned a type of accommodation that offers not only a space for ultimate relaxation – *a hallmark of Alor Divers* – but also a feeling of luxury that some of our guests are looking for.

The 4 bungalows have *custom-made wooden furniture*, designed with focus on comfort and details, and created by *local artisans*. The furniture of Ubur-Ubur and Duri Duri has a *classical tropical touch*, and both Lumba-Lumba and Belo-Belo's own have been created from *recycled timber* from wooden boats, giving a *chic-rustic touch*.

HOW TO GET TO ALOR







It is possible to reach Alor every day from Bali, Jakarta and many other cities in Indonesia. For ease of the diving organization and the resort's logistics, we implement an arrival / departure schedule and policy as follow:

- * Alor airport-resort transfer is free of charge for scheduled arrivals / departures days: every Wednesday and Sunday.
- * Recommended flights in between Kupang and Alor (every day):
- Arrival: 09:15 Wings Air IW1943
- Departure: 09:40 Wings Air IW1942

Our staff will welcome you upon arrival at Alor airport and transfer you to the resort on a 40 minutes car drive from the airport followed by a 20 minutes boat ride across Pantar Strait to reach the resort.

WHEN TO COME?

We are open from mid-March to mid-December; this is the best time of the year for underwater visibility. Summer is very pleasant with dry and cool nights; you may even consider bringing a light jacket to wear in the evening. There is almost NO rain from June to October, so NO mosquito during this period. In summer the sea can be choppy to rough, but most dive sites are protected.

DIVING IN INDONESIA

Just like Komodo, Nusa Penida or Raja Ampat, diving in Alor requires some experience as there can be medium to strong currents: we recommend all divers should have a minimum of 50 logged dives. We will however take care to plan the dives with as little current as possible, keeping our guests' comfort, safety and experience in mind.

IS THERE A BEST SEASON FOR MARINE LIFE?

After more than 10 years diving Alor we have observed a pattern on macro life being more abundant from October to May, including nudibranches. Coral fish are always abundant and pelagic is common encounter.

The rhinopias, stars of Alor, can be spotted all-year round. Sharks are present all year long, mola Mola is often spotted between July and September, whales start to cross the strait in October.
